

COLORIS SUR LA BAIE – 3rd EDITION – 2008

Applicable Criteria during the Art Show

Artists can rent and occupy only one kiosk during the art show. A kiosk cannot be shared with other artists. Artists are entirely responsible for their works of art from the beginning to the end of the show.

The works of art must be framed except for certain modern works which do not require framing, such as gallery style canvases.

The following medium of painting are accepted: oil, acrylic, mixed techniques, pastels, charcoal, ink and watercolour. In photography, artistic supershots are accepted.

Artists may only exhibit original works of art on a subject appropriate to all ages. Reproduction of works, in whole or in part, of other artists' works, photographs, calendars, magazines, etc., is not allowed. Artists can, however, sell cards representing their work (maximum size 5" x 7".)

Artists who wish to paint on site must use a portable easel and a drop cloth. They cannot use any cumbersome material which would impede on space reserved to the visitors and neighbours.

The artists can only exhibit works of art which have been duly registered upon arrival.

PHYSICAL INSTALLATION

The artists must:

- Provide their own 'S' shaped metal hooks to hang their works of art and secure them with the use of plastic ties on the metal grids.
- Hang their works of art aesthetically on the metal grids already installed. Any article extending beyond the grids will not be tolerated
- Harmonize the set up of their kiosks without impeding on their neighbour's space. ***This directive will be strictly enforced.***
- Leave a minimum of three inches between each work
- Limit their publicity to an album, business cards and a guest book. Artists may install a small table (maximum 14" x 20") ***inside their kiosk.***
- Provide their adhesive tape, "S" hooks, plastics ties, and necessary tools.
- Bring their lighting equipment, such as spot lights, extension cords, surge protector power bars, duct tape, etc.
- Ensure that they are replaced during coffee breaks, lunches, etc. This service will be provided by volunteers
- Ensure cleanliness in the alley in front of their kiosk and at the end of the show, clean up their area.
- Store their personal effects and additional works of art in the room provided to that effect.

SALES

Artists are responsible for the sale of their works of art. The service for the use of credit cards will be provided. Although administrative fees will not be collected by Coloris sur la Baie, artists must assume the commission collected by the credit companies

The price list of your works of art must be registered with Coloris sur la Baie upon arrival. For each sale, the artist commits himself to give to Coloris sur la Baie 20% of the registered price. The commissions must be paid prior to the end of the show.

Sold works must be brought by the artist at the Reception Desk, as a mean of control of the sales and commissions and for wrapping

Any sold works of art must be replaced by another registered one.

SECURITY

Coloris sur la Baie, its members, la Résidence Jardins Belle Rive and its employees and residents are not to be held responsible for incurred damages to any and all personal effects and works of art of the artists in the event of fire, theft and/or vandalism. Coloris sur la Baie will provide the service of a security guard overnight.

All members of the Committee of Coloris sur la Baie will be identified by a name tag. They can answer your questions and assist you.
